History of Perpetual Adoration: Although the Real Presence has been recognized since the time of the apostles, evidence shows Perpetual Adoration may have begun in the sixth century in the Cathedral of Lugo, Spain. By the twelfth century, St. Thomas a'Becket is known to have prayed for King Henry II before the "majesty of the Body of Christ," and by the sixteenth century, the devotion known as Forty Hours had developed. In nineteenth century France, Perpetual Adoration developed in communities of contemplative nuns. The devotion eventually spread to parishes throughout the world.
